Foreword

The Chesapeake Swim League was first organized in 1965 to promote an age group competitive swimming program during the summer months between member swim clubs. The intent was to develop sportsmanship, advanced aquatic skills and teamwork. Although the league maintains membership in the South Atlantic Association of the AAU it is not necessarily bound by the rules for the conduct of swimming competition as published in Article III of the AAU handbook. Section III of this handbook prescribes modified rules for swimming competition which will guide the conduct of the league. The league has, however, adopted the rules for swimming the competitive strokes as stated in Article II of the handbook.

Section I

Constitution

- Article I**
Name This organization shall be known as the Chesapeake Swim League
- Article II**
Purpose To Sponsor competitive swimming and other activities among the Clubs, Swim Pools and Organizations in the Chesapeake Bay Area; and to develop in the participants affected by this program a love for the sport, advanced aquatic skill, teamwork, and principles of good sportsmanship.
- Article III**
Membership
1. Membership to the Chesapeake Swim League for any given year shall consist of those Organizations having made a firm commitment to participate in the League's program and work for the ensuing swimming season.
 2. Members of the League are the following Organizations:
 1. Andover Swim Club
 2. Annapolis Country Club
 3. Chartwell Country Club
 4. Crofton Aquatic Club
 5. Crofton Four Seasons Club
 6. Glen Burnie Park Swim Club
 7. Naval Academy Junior Swim Club
 8. Severn Swim Club
 9. Suburbia Swim Club
 10. Sulin's Pool Swim Club
 3. Additional members may be added to the League by a majority vote of the members.
- Article IV**
Officers
1. The governing body of the Chesapeake Swim League shall consist of the duly designated President and one representative from each member organization.
 2. The officers of the League shall be a President; a Secretary; and a Treasurer, elected by the designated representatives.
 3. Officials shall be elected to serve one year terms which shall run from 1 November to 31 October.
 4. Committees shall be appointed to perform the separate functions of the governing body.
 5. The President on assuming office will have the team he represents appoint a new Club representative.
- Article V**
Meetings Meetings will be called by the President of the League as required or at the request of three clubs. A meeting will be held the second week in October to review the League operation and to elect new officers.
- Article VI**
Amendments Amendments to this constitution may be made at any meeting of the Board of Representatives by a 2/3 vote of the voting members. Issues to be voted on are to be furnished to the representatives 30 days prior to the meeting.
